GBM Resolution: 21 October, 2013

1. API:

- We demand that JNU develops an appropriate system of evaluation acknowledging the diversity of research and teaching modalities in the university. Specifically, we demand:
 - IQAC/API FORMAT SHOULD BE SIMPLIFIED AND DEVELOPED TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE SPECIFIC NEEDS AND PRIORITIES OF DIFFERENT SCHOOLS AND SPECIAL CENTRES. WE PREFER A SCHOOL LEVEL IQAC FORMAT AND API SYSTEM.
 - IQAC SHOULD BE DEMOCRATISED: with representations from assistant professors, associate professors, to be selected in consultation with the JNUTA.
 - Appropriate weightage should be given to API score in the selection processes under CAS.
 - o JNUTA committee report on API should be implemented.
- API modifications should be placed before the AC only after proper discussions at the level of Centres/ schools/JNUTA.

2. RE-EMPLOYMENT

• Important policy decisions should be taken by statutory bodies like the Centres /CASR, EC and AC. We reject the recent move to bypass Centres in matters of re-employment. The JNUTA reiterates that the chairpersons should forward any application only after consulting the Centre.

3. SC/ST CELL

• SC/ST CELL SHOULD STOP ASKING FOR DIAGNOSTIC REPORTS for reimbursement of medical expenses at once.

• Any referral from the CMO/MOs should be valid for at least six months.

4. JNU PRESS

• JNU Press should not become a medium of using public funded research for corporate profits.

• Final editorial decision should rest with the JNU appointed review committee.

• The post of Managing editor should be given to a faculty.

• All drafts of the JNU PRESS committee report should be sent to Centres/schools/JNUTA for effective discussion.

5. House allotment ratio for type 4 houses should be changed to reflect the current strength of teaching and non-teaching employees.

6. The GBM resolved that while being an integral part of the FEDCUTA, the JNUTA will make efforts to reach out to other teachers' association in this country (like AIFUCTO) to build up effective teacher's unity ahead of the 7Th Pay Commission.
