JNUTA condemns the attempts to intimidate Academicians

It is unfortunate to note that unscrupulous elements are conspiring to silence all voices that emerge in favour of poor and downtrodden sections of society, especially dalits and tribals. The recent fabricated complain against academicians including Prof. Archana Prasad and Prof. Nandini Sundar following their Chhattisgarh visit is just another example. The state, instead of safeguarding the voices of dissent is protecting those unscrupulous elements; it is also actively participating in intimidating academicians who raise pertinent issue of victimization of innocent tribal from both sides i.e. the Maoists and the Police.
