Applications are invited for **Guest Faculty** in the areas of specialization as indicated against each. The essential qualifications for these positions will be as per the UGC Regulations, 2018, as amended from time to time.

Minimum Qualifications: Guest Faculty (Assistant Professor)

- (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/ relevant/ allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may, be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. program prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions: -

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two externals examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/ seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

- (iii) *The Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor in Universities with effect from 01.07.2021 as per clause 3.10 of the UGC Notification dated 18th July, 2018 'UGC Regulation on Minimum Qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018'.*

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Program in disciplines for which NET/ SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Essential Qualifications: Guest Faculty (Assistant Professor)

- (i) **Computer Science and Engineering:** A BE/BTech and ME/MTech in relevant branch with First Class or equivalent either in BE/BTech or ME/MTech from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) **Electronics and Communication Engineering:** A BE/BTech and ME/MTech in relevant branch with First Class or equivalent either in BE/BTech or ME/MTech from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (iii) **Computational Linguistics:** A Master's degree with 55%marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale where ever the grading system is followed) in language/linguistics or any other concerned/relevant/allied stream from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (iv) **Mechanical Engineering:** A BE/BTech and ME/MTech in relevant branch with First Class or equivalent either in BE/BTech or ME/MTech from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The qualifications and selection procedure for appointment will be the same as applicable to a regularly appointed teacher.
2. The Honorarium for Guest Faculty will be Rs. 1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- per month.
3. The Guest faculty will not be given the benefit of allowances, pension, gratuity and leave etc. as admissible to the regular teachers.

Note:

- (i) A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy Layer)/Differently abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- (iii) A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
- (iv) Candidate(s) from premier institutions (top 50 NIRF ranking) who have submitted their Ph.D. theses for evaluation are also encouraged to apply.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The eligible and interested persons are requested to send his/her **application through e-mail as per the format attached** along with this advertisement.
2. Applicants are requested to kindly attach the copies of the educational qualifications i.e., marksheet, degree, NET certificate, experience certificate etc. alongwith the filled **application form in one combined PDF File**.
3. Qualifications and other conditions applicable are subject to UGC regulations 2018, as amended from time to time.
4. The eligibility of the candidates will be determined based on qualifications/ experience/publications etc. acquired by them upto the last date fixed for receipt of applications.
5. The University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate(s) at any stage in the process of selection in case any inadvertent mistake is detected even after issue of appointment letter for **Guest Faculty**.
6. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by a candidate at any time of appointment as Guest Faculty. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has undesirable/ clandestine antecedents and has suppressed any information, then his/her service shall be terminated.
