| 1. | 2300059074 | <u>Criteria 2:</u> Candidate has claimed 10 publications. Out of which 4 cannot be considered as they are in paid journal, during a single year (2018) and NOT in International Law. They are shown to be published in completely different discipline: “Pure and Applied Mathematics”: (1). Publication No.3 (honor killing in India); (2) No. 6 (enforced disappearance); (3) No. 9 (national security). Moreover, Publication No. 8 is a brief commentary/opinion piece without footnotes in Mainstream Weekly. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2 and 4. <u>Criteria (3):</u> Candidate has claimed 11 Yrs, 8 M experience. Asian African Legal Consultative Organization (AALCO) duration of 5 Yrs, 5 M cannot be considered as is neither teaching nor research institution as required for the post. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2, 3, 4 and 6. |
| 2. | 2300061193 | <u>Criteria 2:</u> Candidate has claimed 9 publications. Out of which 4 are rejected because they are merely compiled reports 'year in review' Annual Survey of Indian Law and not on International Law issues. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2, 3, 4 and 6. |
| 3. | 2300061086 | <u>Criteria 2:</u> Candidate has claimed 9 articles only. Out of the total 9 claimed, 8 cannot be accepted since 2 are (one page) opinion papers published in magazines, 5 are published in Andhra Law Times and 1 in Supreme Court Law Journal (These are primarily judgement reporters - not academic journals). These are NOT research article in journal of international repute. <u>Criteria 3:</u> The candidate has claimed a total of 27 years of experience in the Ministry of Law and Justice holding administrative positions (such as a Legal Assistant and a Legal Advisor). These are NOT teaching and/or research positions required for the post. Candidate has NO teaching and/or research experience. Candidate does not meet Criteria 2, 3, 4 and 6. |
