


JNUTA Elections 2018-19

Rules for Casting votes through Postal Ballot

1. BALLOT should not bear name, signature or any other identification mark of the voter.
2. BALLOT should be put in a sealed envelope, which also should not bear any identification mark of the voter.
3. The candidates being voted for against each post should be clearly indicated.
4. The sealed envelope containing BALLOT should be put in another sealed outer cover which should be signed by the person casting the vote.
5. The faculty on leave can submit the postal ballot either directly to the election officer or send it by post to the election officer at the address below, or send it through a colleague. In case they opt for last option, they must send **an email to the election officer at (kumarr.narender@gmail.com)** stating the nature of leave they are on and the person to whom they have given the postal ballot. The email should reach before the voting is over.
6. The POSTAL BALLOT must reach the election officer before the end of voting on November 1, 2018.
7. Any POSTAL BALLOT that is not secret will be considered invalid.
8. Sending votes through email will not be accepted.
9. Opting for more than ONE option will make all the options INVALID.
